ELIGIBILITY:

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

1. The contestant will present an art, science, or cooking lesson, 10-15 minutes in length, that is suitable for a group of 4 to 6 preschool-age children. Contestants will be stopped after 15 minutes.
2. Before beginning the presentation, the contestant will be given a 10-minute preparation time in order to arrange materials, resources, and to engage the children.
3. The contestant must bring all materials necessary for presentation and clean-up.

EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS:

To be supplied by chairperson:

- Location for the contest
- A person to supervise the children
- All materials for judging

To be supplied by contestant:

- A presentation developed according to the guidelines
- Visuals, props, art supplies, science supplies or all items necessary for a cooking project
- Supplies to clean up after presentation
- Typed information sheets (4 copies) to include:
 - a. Purpose
 - b. Steps to be followed
 - c. Resources/materials
- Name and school must NOT appear on the information sheets.
