ELIGIBILITY:

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

Contestants will be given a 5-minute warm-up. The contest will include two 5-minute timed writings with a maximum of 10 errors allowed. A penalty of one word per error will be assessed. The wrap around feature will be included in the keyboarding program.

This program gives students a choice of one space or two spaces after a period.

EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS:

To be supplied by chairperson:

- An area for the contest, including computer hardware and software
- All testing materials
- All judging materials

To be supplied by contestant:

- Pencils

TIME:

Roll will be taken at 9 a.m.

SCORECARD:

Contestants will be given two 5-minute writings. Only those with 10 errors or less will be judged. For every error, a one-word penalty will be subtracted from their gross speed.
