CLASS:

Medical Occupations – Medical Terminology, Hospital Health Occupations, Nursing Assistant, Home Health Aide, Foundations of Medical Assisting, Essentials of Nursing

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all students enrolled in a related class or who feel they have the skills to compete. Refer to the General Information and Rules page.

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

This event shall be a written examination dealing with selected terms common to Health Career Education. Competitors shall be expected to recognize, identify, define, interpret and apply these terms by responding correctly to 100 multiple choice items.

TIME:

Roll will be taken at 9 a.m. The time allowed for this competition is 2 HOURS.

SCORECARD:

1. Roots, prefixes, suffixes, and combining forms will be approximately 45% of the test. Overview of the Body, Skeletal, Muscular, Respiratory, Digestive, Cardiovascular and Lymphatic, Nervous/ Special Senses
2. Endocrine, Reproductive, Integumentary, and Urinary Systems will be approximately 5% each of the remainder of the test.

TIE BREAKER:

A series of 20 tie-breaking questions will be asked as part of the original test and shall be graded in the event of a tie. In the tie-breaker, correct spelling is required for an item to be considered.

Since this is the first year of this event, no cash prizes will be awarded.
