Journalism or Photography (news, feature, sports content, or on-the-spot)

ELIGIBILITY:

Refer to General Information and Rules page.

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

1. Contestants must submit original work only. On-the-spot photos will be taken during the contest period at COS and will cover some aspect of the Giant Tech Prep EXPO or of campus activity.
2. All photos must be digital. Only digital cameras with removable cards can be used. Students must provide their own cards. For purposes of this competition, **cards must be empty at the start of competition**. Cards will be turned in at the end of the competition and returned to students after the awards ceremony. Students must bring their own cameras, lenses and other equipment they want to use for the competition.
3. Contestants must be present and on time to participate in the on-the-spot contest.
4. On-the-spot photos will be evaluated for composition and technical skills.

EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS:

To be supplied by contestant:

- digital camera, lenses, other equipment wanted for competition.
- removable card that is empty at start of competition.

TIME:

Contestants can begin when they arrive, after they obtained instructions from the contest moderators outside next to the main registration site. Cards must be turned in by the deadline printed on the instruction form obtained on the day of the competition. **Cards must contain only the 8 photos selected by the contestant for submission to judges.**

SCORECARD:

Contestants will be judged on composition and technical photo skills as evident on digital photos submitted on the card.
