CLASS:

Open to students enrolled in, or that have completed, Spanish III or its equivalent.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all students having the necessary skills to participate in the competition. Refer to General Information and Rules page.

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

1. Students will be given an essay/passage/dialogue type-written in Spanish. Students will have 45 minutes to translate it into English and either type or write the English translation.
2. Pens and binder paper will be provided. Some computers may be available.
3. Contestant must be present and on time in order to participate.

TIME:

Roll will be taken at 9 a.m. The time allowed for this competition is 1 HOUR. Contestants will be evaluated on their ability to complete the project within the time specified.

 - Spelling
 - Grammar
 - Punctuation
 - Capitalization
 - Accuracy
